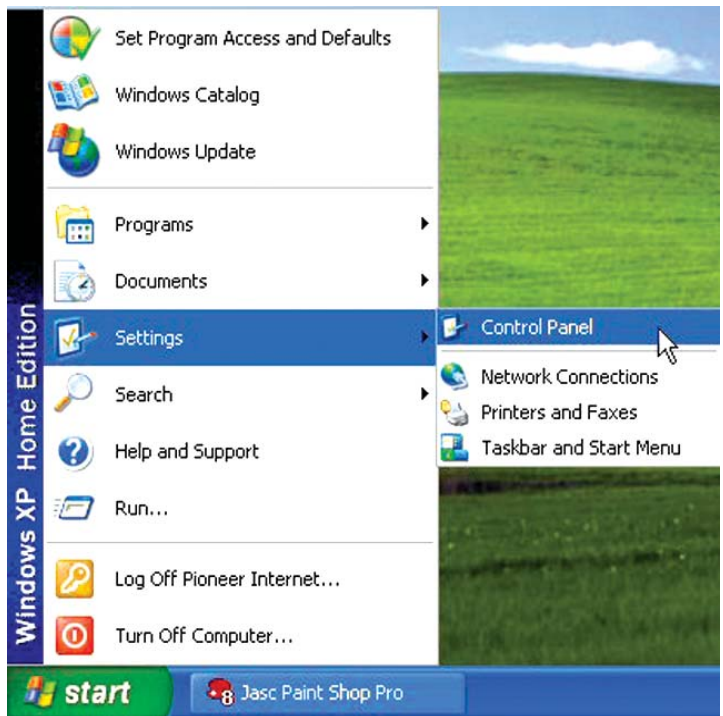
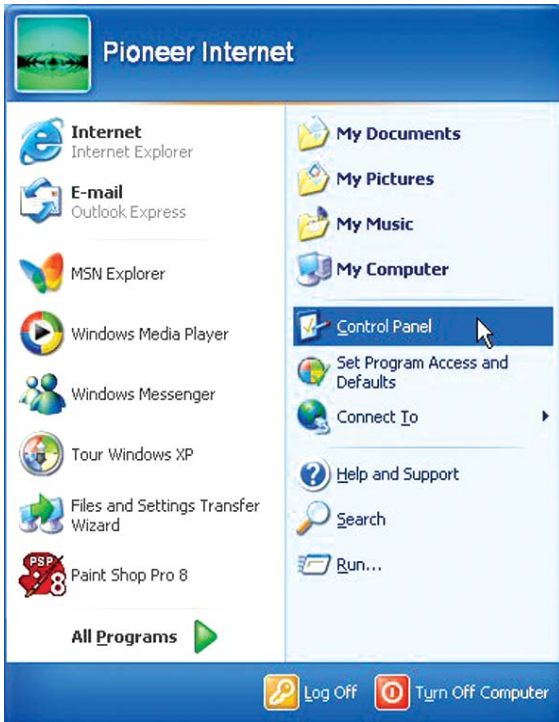
1. To set up a Pioneer High-Speed Internet connection on Windows XP, click **Start**.



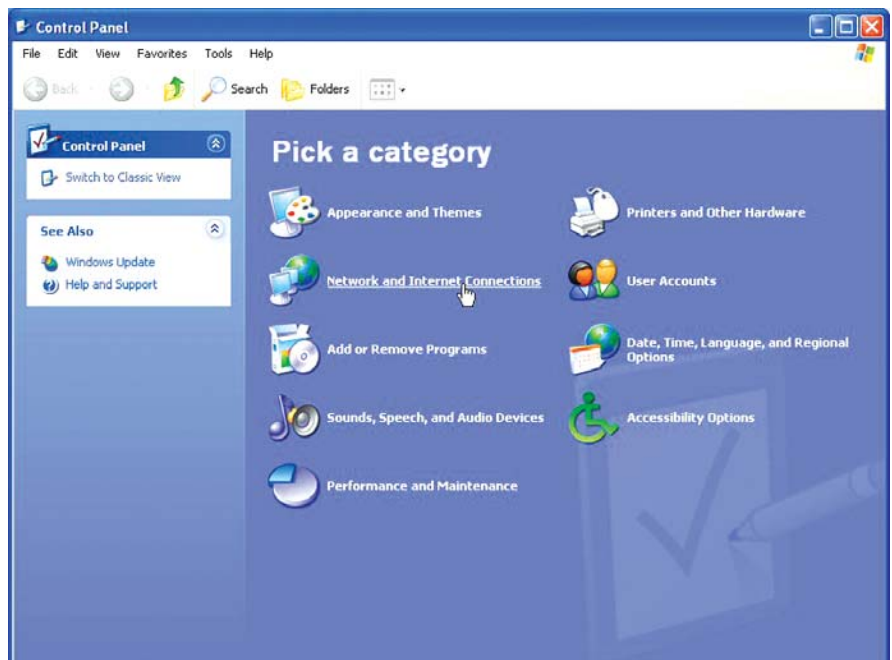
2. There are two different Start menu configuration options:

If the Start menu appears like the one on the left, click on **Control Panel**.

If the Start menu appears like the one on the right, click **Settings**, then **Control Panel**.

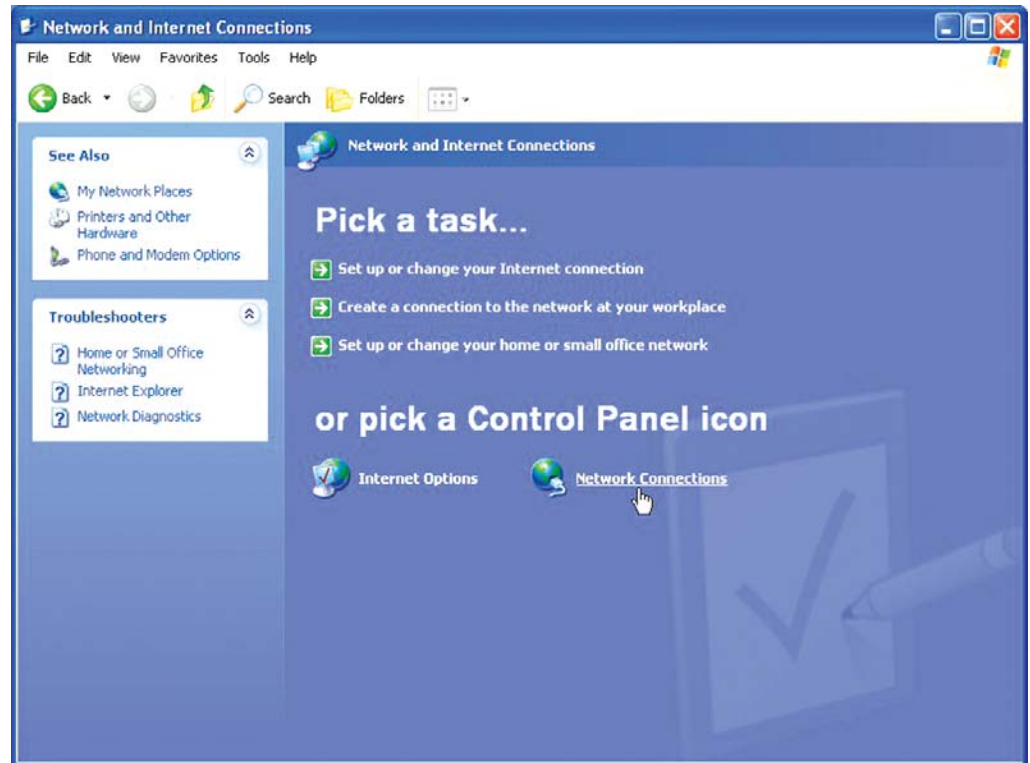


3. In the control panel, click on **Network and Internet Connections**. (Note: Some computer configurations may not show Network and Internet Connections due to the different layout possibilities of the Control Panel. If the Control Panel appears as below, skip step 5. If Network and Internet Connections is not displayed, please skip steps 3 and 4 and proceed to step 5.)

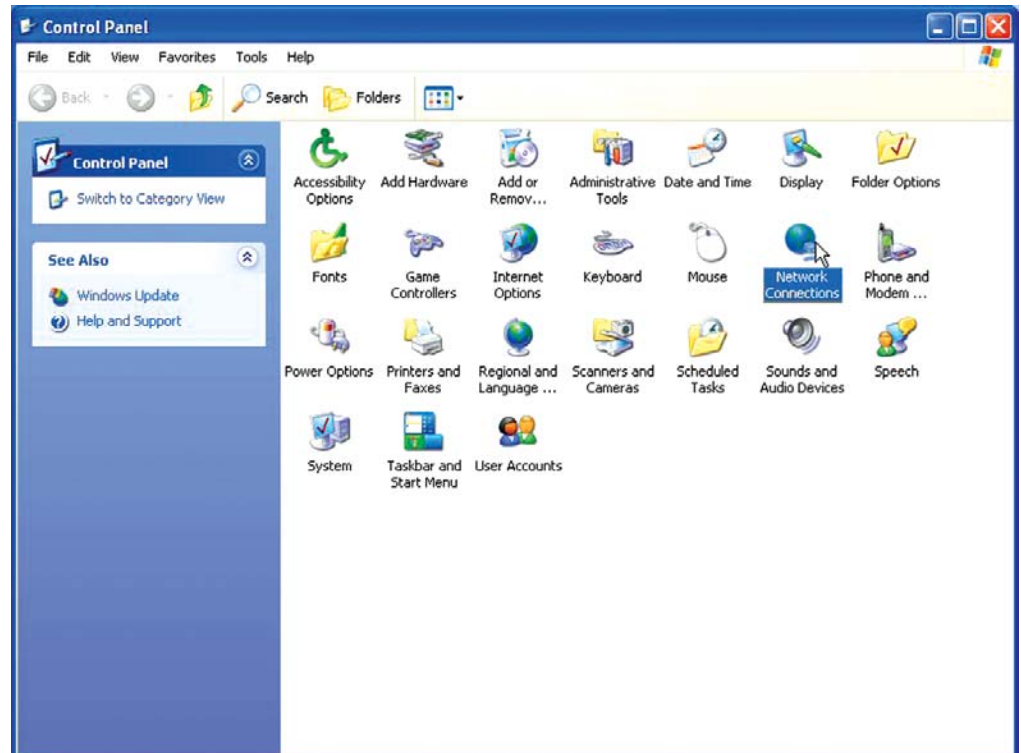

4. Click **Network Connections**.

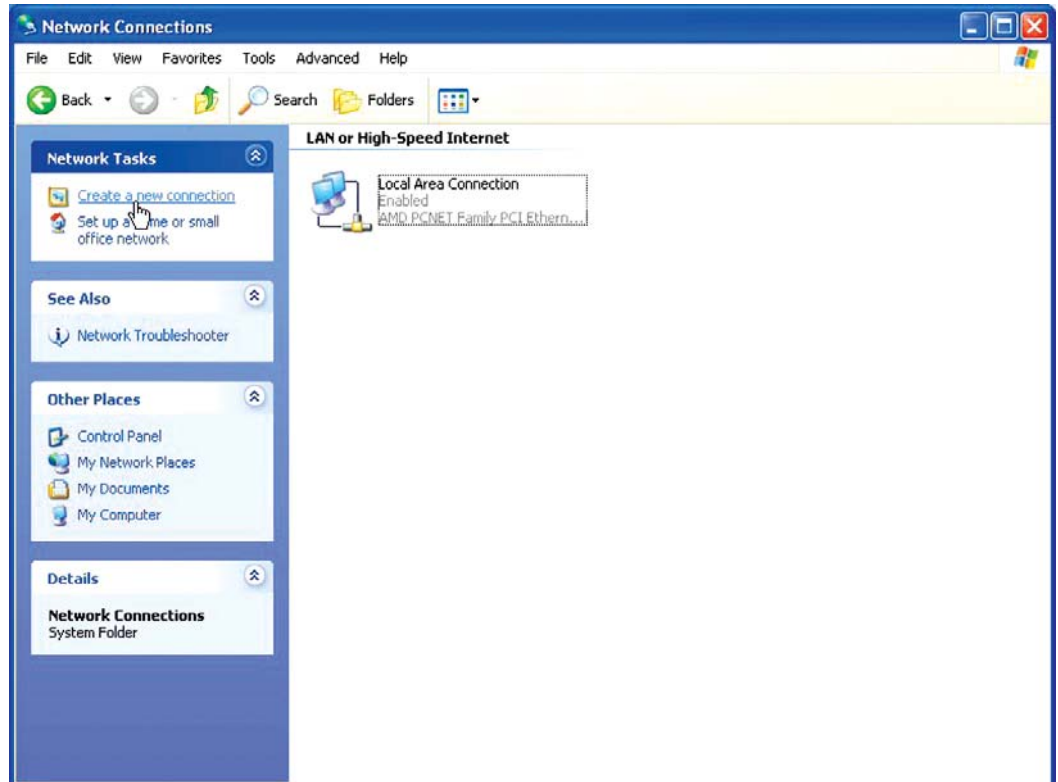


5. This window will only be displayed if the Control Panel is set to display in Classic View. If the Control Panel is displayed as follows double-click **Network Connections**.

6. In Network Connections click on **Create a new connection** listed under Network Tasks.

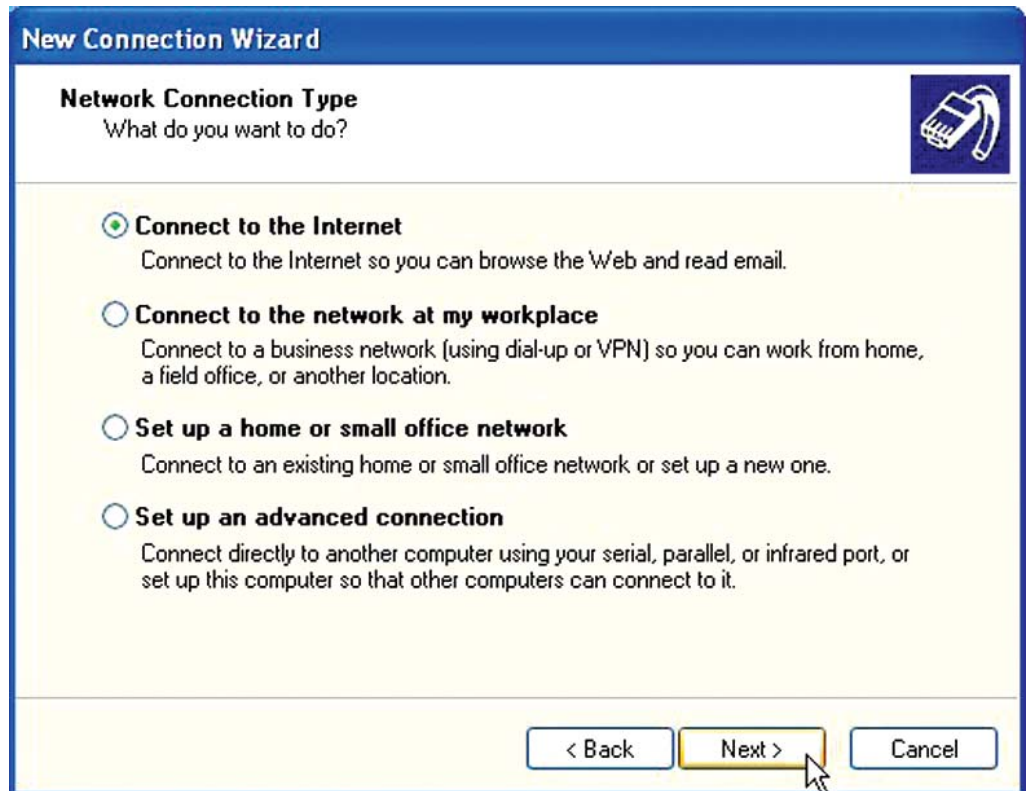


7. When the New Connection Wizard window displays, click Next.

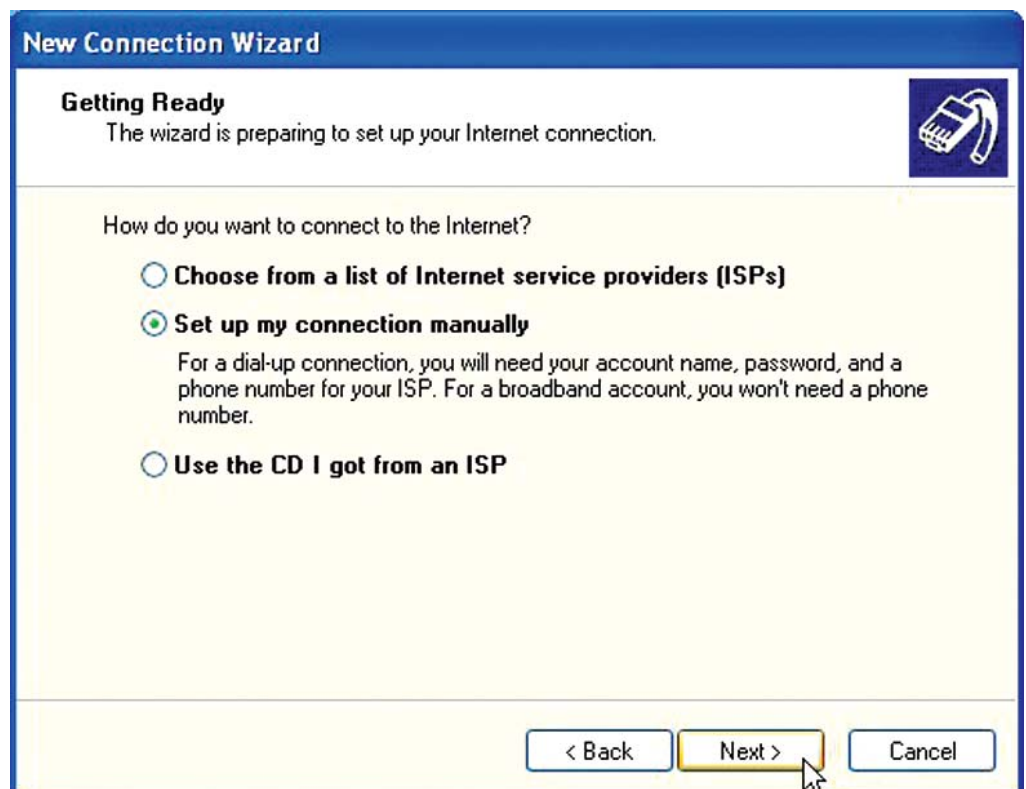

8. On the following screen, verify **Connect to the Internet** is selected and click **Next**.




9. On the following screen, select **Set up my connection manually**. Click **Next**.






11. On the following screen, type **Pioneer High-Speed** for the ISP Name and click Next.

14. After the connection has been completed, the following window will appear. To connect to Pioneer High-Speed Internet click **Connect**.
